- 1. A gives ten strokes with a stick to B. Can A be punished separately for each stroke?
- 2. A, by force, compels B, a person aged 35 years and of sound mind, to go from India to Nepal. Has A committed the offence of kidnapping?
- 3. W, a woman intentionally put poison into the food of her husband H for causing death of H. H died sometimes afterwards from inflammation of the brain. During trial the prosecution could adduce no evidence that the poison was even the secondary cause of the death of H. Is W guilty of 'murder' or 'attempt to murder' of H under section 302 or under section 307? Give reasons and also refer to the case law, if any, on the point.
- 4. A is likely to beat B. B in exercise of his right of private defence, catches hold of A, so that A could not beat him. By such action of B, A is excited to sudden and violent passion and kills B. What offence, if any, committed by A?
