Q. 'A' catches fish from a tank in the night and is caught by the chowkidar when 'A' is loading them in the truck. Is 'A' guilty of theft and if so, why?

Q. A introduces water into an ice-house belonging to Z, thus causes the ice to melt, intending wrongful loss to Z. Has A committed any offence?

Q. A, by exhibiting to Z a false sample of an article intentionally deceives Z into believing that the article corresponds with the sample, and thereby induces Z to buy and pay for the article. Discuss A's offence.

Q. Examine the criminal liability that can be attached in the following situation with the legal reasoning: 'A' wrote a letter to a widow asking her to pay balance amount for the work he did during the lifetime of her husband. He wrote that in case she failed to deliver money than her husband would face divine displeasure. Can 'A' be charged with the offence of extortion?
